

Coffee Morning November 2009

NEVER-ENDING CARD

You will need:

2 square pieces of card. (I used A4 sheets and trimmed to make them square)

Ruler & pencil

Bone folder

Pictures and paper to decorate. (using the A4 card gives 21 cm a side)

- 8 squares 9x9 cm
- 10 strips 9x4 cm
- 8 squares 4x4 cm

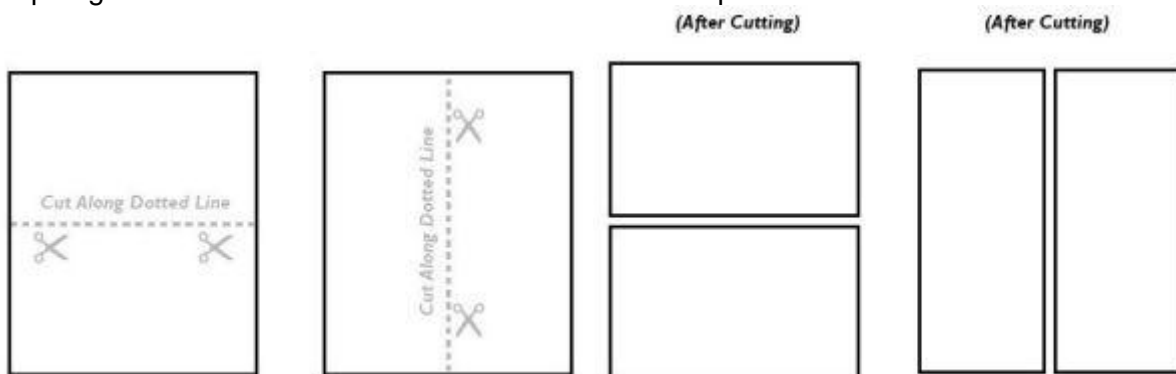
Or stamps to fit

Method

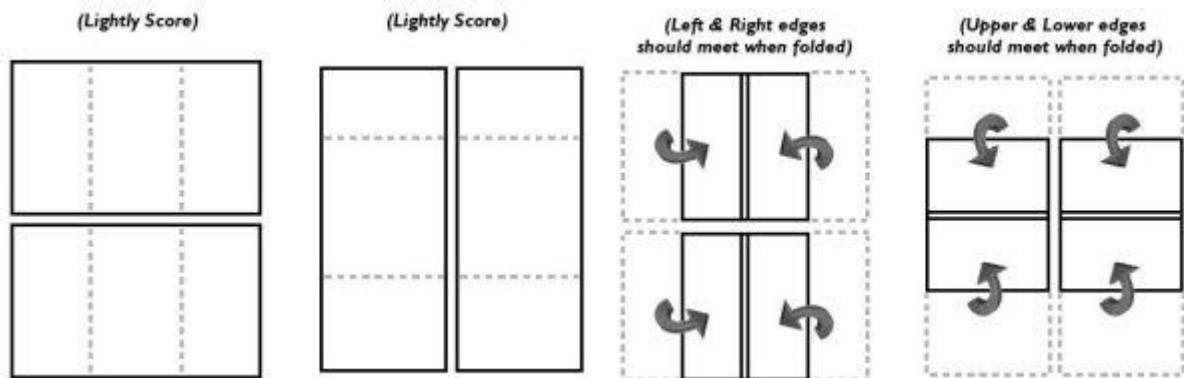
Mark with pencil the centre of 2 sides of the card.

Cut each piece of card in two halves.

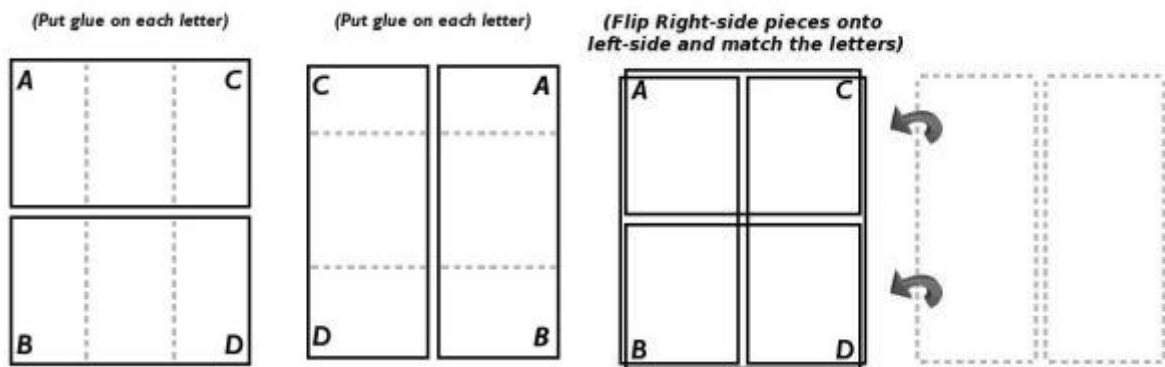
Carefully fold the edges into the centre to form a gatefold, and crease with a bone folder to get crisp edges. Fold the creases back on themselves and press with the bone folder.



Lay the two halves of one piece flat, then lay the two halves of the second on top but turned through 90°



Glue the four corners together keeping outside of any creases. It may make it easier to put a letter in each corner



You should not see any letters after doing this - they should be glued together.

This forms the basis of the card and you should be able to fold it over and over through the gatefolds to bring you back to the beginning.

Use the pictures etc to decorate.

This card is not suitable for decoupage or bulky embellishments
